



## Leaflet on formalities of the doctoral thesis

The doctoral procedure is regulated in the [Doctoral Regulations of 2010](#) and is supplemented by subject-specific supplements of the Chemistry Doctoral Committee, according to which this information sheet is based.

One (1) examination copy has to be produced in the following format:

- printed on both sides // 80 g/m<sup>2</sup> paper // DIN-A4 format // permanently bound (no spiral binding)
- upload an electronic version in Docata (max. 20 MB)

### Structure of the dissertation (guideline)

<b>Title page</b>	Name of the author, naming the faculty and the institute, (in case of interdisciplinary dissertation state all departments involved), additionally the designation as a "dissertation submitted to the University of Hamburg" and the year of submission. NO Small Capitals in the title.
<b>Sheet 1</b>	(Names of the reviewers, oral defense committee, date of disputation and/or (if different) date of print release) <sup>1</sup>
<b>Sheet 2</b>	Explanation of where and in which period the dissertation has been carried out

- II. Table of content
- III. List of abbreviations

- 1) German Abstract Short summary of the thesis in German (approx. 1 page).
- 2) English Abstract Short summary of the thesis in English (approx. 1 page).
